Press Release:

The Town of Portland has received a shipment of N95 masks and very limited number of at-home COVID-19 test kits (672). Both the masks and the test kits will be available to Portland residents on **Sunday January 2, 2022**.

Location: Portland High School, 95 High Street
Time: 9:00 AM until 1:00 PM or until supplies last

- Due to the limited number of test kits, only one (1) test kit per household will be issued.
- The Department of Public Health has asked that kits be prioritized to those individuals who are considered as either high-risk, front line workers, those showing symptoms, and those who have had close contact with someone who has tested COVID positive. **Please do not pick up a test kit unless you fall into one of those categories.**
- Proof of residency required (i.e. driver's license)
- Do not exit your vehicle, you will be handed one (1) at-home test kit and two (2) N95 masks from inside your vehicle.
- Please travel to Portland High School from the William Street side of High Street. The north bound lane of High Street will be closed from Spring Street to Butler Lane.

Additional test kits may become available in the near future. Please continue to check the town's website for updates.
