## **Community Partners Program Recognition Awards Breakfast Held**

The Economic Development Commission (EDC) held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Community Partners Program Awards Ceremony on Thursday, March 18, 2010 at the Portland Senior Center, 7 Waverly Avenue. The Community Partners Program was developed and implemented by the EDC in 2008 as a way to recognize the vital contributions Portland businesses make to the many charitable, recreational, and educational activities offered in Portland and neighboring communities.

The Community Partners Program has two levels of recognition. The Member Level recognizes businesses for donations of goods or services of up to \$5,000 in value during the previous calendar year. The Gold Member Level recognizes business for donations of goods and services in excess of \$5,000 during the previous calendar year. One hundred thirty eight Portland businesses were recognized for contributions to the community, with twenty businesses recognized for contributions in excess of \$5,000. Donations included contributions to charitable organizations, community events, local schools, fundraising programs, sponsorship of sports teams and municipal services.

The businesses recognized received a certificate as well as a window decal to display at their place of business. The decal recognizes the contributions made by the business and reminds customers of the importance of local businesses contributions in the success of community, educational and charitable programs. Portland residents are urged to look for these decals and support local businesses that so generously support the community. Businesses that made charitable contributions during the last year but did not complete the application process prior to the awards ceremony may do so at anytime and receive a decal recognizing them as a Community Partner. #### **EDC Informational Breakfast Series**

The next EDC Informational Breakfast will be held on Thursday, April 1st at 10 a.m. at the Portland Senior Center, 7 Waverly Avenue. The guest speaker will be Jeffrey Gebrian of CR3 Site Planning and Landscape Architects. CR3 has been contracted by the Town of Portland as the Design Consultant for the Village District Overlay Zone. CR3 will be responsible for review and design recommendations to the Planning and Zoning Commission for all construction, rehabilitation, and façade changes within the Village District. This program is open to all Portland residents and business owners and provides a wonderful opportunity to speak with Jeff about his impressive body of work and his vision for Portland's Main Street.

## Country Market Building To Become New Home of MHS Primary Care

The former Country Market building located at 270 Main Street is undergoing extensive renovations. The building was purchased by 270 Main Street, LLC. The group, which includes developers William H. Coons Jr. and William H. Coons III along with East West Real Estate Associates, has been committed to completing this project for nearly a year. Negotiations, to not only purchase the building, but also ensure tenants suitable for the Village District, began in the spring of April 2009. Despite delays in finalizing the many contracts, the group remained committed to becoming a part of Portland's business community.

The plan will create modern medical office space in the heart of the Village District. The facility will be modeled after another project the developers completed at 80 Shunpike Road in Cromwell. The central location and mix of commercial and retail properties along Main Street were key components in the decision to bring a medical project to Portland. Parking spaces will remain in front of the building and the municipal lot adjacent to the building will be serviced by a newly created rear entrance being added as a part of the renovation.

The largest tenant will be the Middlesex Hospital group, MHS Primary Care, Inc. By June, Dr. George Rosenfeld and his staff will be working at the newly renovated building. The move will provide more space for the practice to implement an expansion plan. Currently, Dr. Rosenfeld and a nurse practitioner staff the office. The additional space, will allow the practice the ability to add more providers to the existing staff. With the relocation also comes the conversion to all electronic medical record keeping. The practice will maintain their current hours: Monday through Thursday 8 am to 9 pm, Friday 8 am to 5 pm, and two Saturday mornings per month.

Robert's Physical and Aquatic Therapy also plans to occupy the space. The physical therapy group specializes in treating injuries and musculoskeletal problems. Robert's Physical and Aquatic Therapy currently operates an office in Old Saybrook. The new office will offer residents in Portland and neighboring towns an alternative to traditional physical therapy methods in a convenient downtown location.
