<u>Qualifications</u>: Associates degree or equivalent from a recognized college in chemistry, biology or environmental science, plus 2-years of progressively responsible experience in laboratory testing work, including 1-year in a waste water facility, or equivalent combination of education and experience. Must have valid CT Driver's License, Class I Wastewater Operator Certification, and Class I Wastewater Analysis Certificate.

## Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Performs specialized chemical, biological and physical tests in laboratory
- Prepares stock chemical solutions to be used in chemical analysis and makes calculations and conversions using mathematical formulas for the purpose of report forms and data analysis
- Performs quality control test analysis in accordance with D.E.E.P. Quality Control Standards
- Assembles data, maintains records and prepares periodic reports. Maintains inventory of chemical and supplies and re-orders, as required
- Reviews technical journals for relevant information
- Performs various plant operations and duties such as reading various gauges and recording results. Inspects equipment and performs maintenance functions
- Performs maintenance on facility and property, such as cleaning and related tasks
- Instructs and ensures proper and safe work practices. May train personnel assigned to the laboratory
